

A/C System Check

- Advanced indoor air quality test
- Clean condensation line, flush and test
- Check float switch and check for proper operation
- Inspect cleanliness of evaporator coil and pan
- Replace customer supplied filter
- Clean vegetation around condenser & clean coil
- Check thermostat for accuracy and check and replace battery if needed
- Visual inspection of duct work, and leak check
- Test A/C unit
- Check supply and return temperatures
- Check AMP draws on all motors and systems
- Check refrigerant pressures
- Check all connections and contacts
- Check all capacitors for proper size and operation
- Check blower wheel for cleanliness and balance

Plumbing Inspection

- Inspect & test all valves in home to make sure they are operational and have no leaks
- Check and locate main water valve
- Check pressure to the home
- Check all drains for leaks
- Check all water lines for leaks
- Check washing machine hoses
- Check all supply lines
- Dye test all toilets and check for leaks, inspect components, and change flappers in up to 2 toilets if needed
- Flush 1 standard tank, or 1 tankless water heater
- Check age and condition of water heater
- Check garbage disposal for proper operation and check for leaks
- Standard Aerator Replacements
- Test the homes water quality

Heating System Check

- Advanced indoor air quality test
- Check the ignition burner assembly on homes with furnaces
- Check filters and filter housings
- Carefully inspect heating elements or heat exchanger. If these get damaged, they could lead to problems with carbon monoxide
- Inspect the flue system and make sure it is securely attached to the furnace
- Check for gas leaks around system
- Check belts and pulleys
- Check drain lines and pans of standing water to prevent overflows
- Check wiring and electrical connections
- Check all moving parts such as bearings and motors
- Check thermostats and controls to ensure they are reading the right temperatures
- Visually check accessible duct work to ensure there are no holes, tears, or kinks.
- Check for carbon monoxide, and if there are carbon monoxide detectors within the home
- Check refrigerant pressures (heat pump)
- Inspect interior and exterior heat pump condenser (heat pump)
- Check and flame sensor
